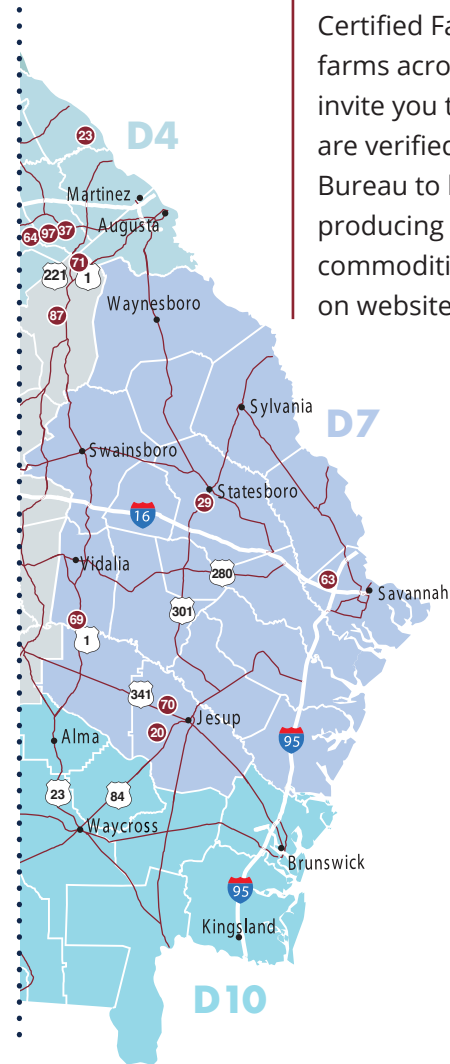
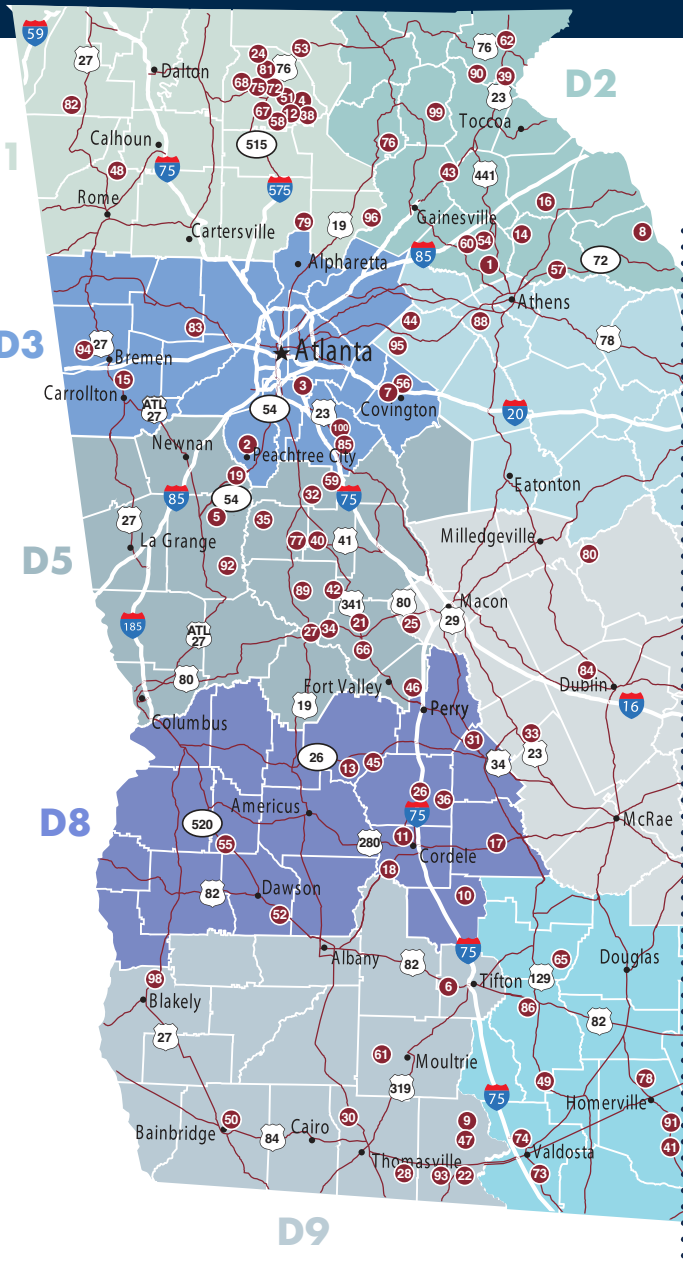

YOUR PASSPORT TO FRESH, FARM-RAISED GOODS



Visit GFB Certified Farm Markets around the state and earn prizes!

Certified Farm Markets are farms across the state that invite you to visit them. They are verified by Georgia Farm Bureau to be an actively producing farm with the commodities they grow listed on website at the bottom.

OFFICIAL RULES

HOW IT WORKS

As you visit participating farms, ask the farmer to stamp your passport. The more stamps you receive, the more prizes you will earn!

1. Be sure to check the farm website/social media or call before visiting to make sure the farm is open.
2. One passport allowed per person.
3. You MUST be present to get a stamp. If anyone takes an extra passport with them for a stamp, they will lose 2 stamps per extra passport in their possession and per report. Additionally, the extra passport owners will lose 2 stamps.
4. Only one stamp per farm.
5. We strongly encourage a purchase at each farm as the farms must pay to be in this program. Farms are allowed to require a purchase for a stamp.
6. Passports must be stamped between March 2024 – December 2024.
7. Deadline to submit a Farm Passport is **January 6, 2025**. Don't worry, we'll return it to you with your prizes.
8. The purpose of mailing in your Passport is to verify farm stamps. Therefore, mail in your whole Passport booklet.
9. Do not call or try to visit a farm in their off season.
10. Respect farmers' privacy & farm boundaries.

HOW TO EARN PRIZES

5 stamps – Limited Edition T-shirt

10 stamps – Awesome Ag Swag (*see last page) + T-shirt

20 stamps – Farm tour with Farm to Table meal for one in spring of 2025 + T-shirt + Ag Swag

30 stamps- Special Selection of Certified Farm Market Goods (*see last page) + All of the Above

All stamps- Everyone who goes to every single farm in a single year to get their stamps will receive The Traveler Jacket

The most stamps- the person(s) with the most stamps will get a RTIC cooler and an ice cream farm date with a farmer, GFB President Tom McCall and Program Coordinator Kelly Henry.



HOW TO CLAIM YOUR PRIZES

Step 1

Fill in your information on the next page.

Step 2

Submit your passport information on www.gfb.ag/PassportSubmission at the end of your travels.

Step 3

Mail in your Farm Passport by **Jan. 6, 2025**.

TIPS

- Look at the big map on the very 1st page before starting any road trip to see which farms are in the direction you are going.
- Optional routes with fun stops crafted to maximize your farm visits and discovery of the state can be found at gfb.ag/PassportRoutes.
- Review the “Icon Legends” from time to time to recognize when a farm is cash only, has special events/activities you should look up the date for, or offers educational classes you can ask about.
- When reading the following maps, note the bold, white lines are interstate highways and the red lines are either U.S. highways (shields) or state highways (circles.) Thin white lines are county outlines.

- Farms are greatly affected by the weather; it can shorten, lengthen, delay, or speed up a crop's season or close the farm for a day(s).

I recently read a study from the American Farmland Trust with some pretty staggering statistics: "Between 2001 and 2016 alone, 11 million acres of the nation's irreplaceable agricultural land was lost or fragmented, equal to all the land in the U.S. used to produce fruits, vegetables and nuts in 2017." Georgia has been ranked #5 among the states for the most threatened agricultural land, and there are 5 times as many producers over 65 as under 35 years old. We saw during the pandemic how important it is to know a farmer and have the fortune of buying direct. I hope we don't forget or minimize this.

This program is about more than earning a prize; it's about protecting our heritage so that the next generation is allowed the same fortunes as we have. As you begin your farm journey across the state, know that your decisions are important. It is your decision to directly support a Georgia farm with your words and your wallet, and your decision to be a Georgia Farm Bureau member to help protect and ensure a future for farms.

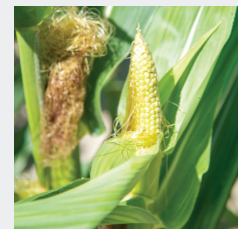
