- Mother's Day in May is one of the biggest holidays for cut flowers, as well as Valentine's in February, but did you know that Christmas and Hanukkah actually top the list in sales? Easter and Passover are popular as well.
- Flower farmers can only provide in-season blooms, but thanks to Georgia's climate, the season can stretch from late winter all the way through fall. The blooms that do best here are acclimated to both heat and humidity.
- According to the University of Georgia Center for Agribusiness and Economic Development, greenhouses are the No. 7 commodity by value in Georgia at \$444 million.
- Ornamental horticulture is ranked the No. 4 commodity group in Georgia. It contributes 10.1 billion dollars and 66,900 jobs to the Georgia economy!
