


Hi! I'm Billy Blueberry This is My Story by Brandon Wade

Billy Blueberry is an illustrated children's book that tells the story of Billy Blueberry. The story covers his entire life cycle from first planting of a blueberry bush, to being picked and eventually being shipped all around the world.





Fun Facts:

- Blueberries are a good source of vitamin C, iron and fiber. They're cholesterol-free, sodium-free and an important source of potassium. They contain only 80 calories per cup.
- The harvest season for fresh blueberries in Georgia is May through mid-July.
- In Georgia, blueberries are grown commercially primarily in the southern part of the state, especially around Alma. Some blueberries are, however, successfully grown in the north Georgia mountains.
- North America produces 95 percent of the world's commercial blueberry crop.
- The blueberry is one of the only foods that is truly naturally blue in color.
- A single blueberry bush can produce as many as 6,000 blueberries per year.
- The blueberry (genus *Vaccinum*) is one of the only commercially available fruits that is native to North America.
