


Harriet's Hungry Worms by Samantha Smith

Packed with worm facts, Harriet's Hungry Worms is the ideal companion for worm warriors and curious composters keen to roll their sleeves up and put their kitchen food scraps to good use. Continuing the sustainability message, inventive illustrations incorporating recycled materials bloom from each page, breathing beautiful life into this fun-filled story.



Fun Facts:

- The most common earthworms used in vermicomposting are the red wrigglers and the European live night crawlers.
- The average lifespan of an earthworm is a year.
- Compost worms eat on average half their own weight in food every day
- Compost worms love kitchen scraps and organic matter such as vegetable and fruit scraps, used tea bags, crushed eggshells, grass clippings and dry leaves
- Red wiggler worms, under good conditions, can lay two to four cocoons in a week. Each cocoon contains about 4 to 6 baby worms and the eggs will usually go through an incubation process of 23 days.
