


Ag in the Classroom Book of the Month

Fun Facts:

- The name catfish refers to the long barbels, or feelers, which are present about the mouth of the fish and resemble cat whiskers. The barbels are used to help find food.
- Catfish have no scales.
- Georgia's public waterways are home to several species of catfish, including channel, white, blue, flathead and bullheads (consisting of several similar species—yellow, brown, snail, spotted and flat).
- Georgia is home to 500,000 acres of lakes, 12,000 miles of warm water streams and 4,000 miles of trout streams.
- Georgia's state fish is the largemouth bass, the state cold water game fish is the Southern Appalachian brook trout, and the state saltwater fish is the red drum.
- There are seven state operated warm water fish hatcheries that supply Georgia with fish from striped bass to catfish and bream. There are numerous private fish farms across the state as well.
- There are public fishing areas throughout the state. Go Fish Center in Perry, Georgia allows fieldtrips!
