

Scholarship Application

The Paulding County Farm Bureau recognizes the critical importance of agriculture in our society and is committed to investing in our students. The Paulding County Farm Bureau will award a \$1000 scholarship to qualified high school seniors who plan to pursue a degree in agriculture, Family/Consumer Sciences, forestry, medicine or a related ag field.

This scholarship is available to Paulding County residents who are graduating high school seniors accepted for admission at an accredited Georgia college or university.

Guidelines:

- **1.** The award will be issued in accordance with the rules set forth in the guidelines in this document as well as completion of the application.
- **2.** An award of \$1000 to be used for tuition and/or fees required for enrollment, books, supplies and/or equipment required for course work in the chosen major at an accredited Georgia college or university will be available for a qualified student at each of our five Paulding County high schools.
- **3.** Should a qualified applicant not be available from each of the five high schools, the Paulding County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee reserves the right to:
 - **a)** select more than one qualified applicant from a Paulding County High School.
 - **b)** increase the amount of the scholarship funds by dividing the total available scholarship funds (\$5000) equally among the qualified recipients.
- **4.** It is the responsibility of the recipient to furnish any needed information (acceptance letters, proof of enrollment) required for disbursement of scholarship funds. The recipient should allow four weeks for processing and be aware of all scholarship deadlines.
- **5.** Payment will be made to the student through the accredited college or university Financial Aide office. Local Scholarship monies should be used within one (1) year.
 - **a)** Unused scholarship funds will be returned to the grantor, Paulding County Farm Bureau.
- **6.** Failure to meet the application deadline will result in the application not being considered.

Any other materials will not be considered.
